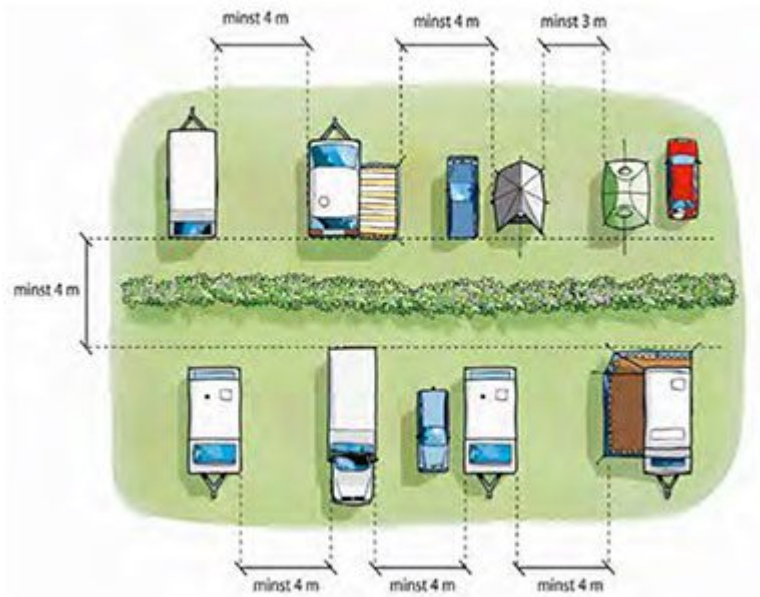

Place rules

These rules are intended to ensure that all guests have a pleasant stay, so that they leave and return with beautiful memories.

1. Please register at reception first upon arrival. Groups are registered by the group leader. Please also indicate if you have additional tents, boats, etc.
2. Only one motor vehicle is permitted per rented campsite/cabin. The vehicle must be parked at the campsite or in front of the cabin. If you have several vehicles, they must be parked in the designated space. Our staff will be happy to help you. Everyone is happy to have visitors! If you, as our guest, receive temporary visitors, they must park their vehicles in the parking lot outside the campsite .
3. The campsite owners and staff ensure peace and order on the site. Their instructions must be followed. If problems arise, they will be happy to help.
4. Any tent equipment of normal type and size may be used. However, it is not permitted to build buildings of a permanent nature. Caravans must be registered for use with a motorized vehicle.
5. Own fixed facilities for tents or caravans, such as: Fences and protective ramps are not permitted. Ask if you have any doubts about what is allowed. Ensure that LPG and electrical appliances are tested and approved in accordance with applicable regulations.
6. Do not disturb the peace of the campsite more than absolutely necessary with a motorized vehicle. The maximum permitted speed is 10 km/h. Vehicle traffic on the site is not permitted between 23:00 and 06:00.
7. Consideration is generally required on campsites. Disturbing behaviour will not be tolerated. The campsite must be quiet between 11pm and 7am.
8. Help children find suitable places to play and play ball games. A special play and ball game area is set up in front of the service house. Throwing or kicking a ball between the tents and caravans is not permitted.
9. Dogs and cats are welcome guests, but must always be kept on a leash and are not allowed in our common service areas or in cabins where pets are not allowed. We ask pet owners to ensure cleanliness in the area.
10. Sales on and within the campsite may only take place with the approval of the campsite operator.
11. Help keep the campsite clean and trash-free . Use the containers available. Be careful not to throw any glowing charcoal or other flammable objects into our waste containers.

12. Leave the common areas and household items (toilets, laundry and shower rooms, kitchen and dishes, washing machine and dryer) in the clean condition in which you would like them to be found.
13. Cancellation of holiday homes
 - Up to 1 week before arrival: full refund/no payment
 - Up to 3 days before arrival: 50% of payment - Less than 3 days before arrival: full payment
14. On the day of departure you must thoroughly clean your pitch or cabin. If you live in a cabin, you will find cleaning instructions and cleaning equipment there. We can also take care of the final cleaning for you. Simply ask at reception about this.
15. The campsite owner or staff are not liable for damage or loss of belongings of camping guests. Anyone who damages buildings, materials or guests' property will be liable for damages.
16. We assume that all camping guests show consideration for one another and ensure order. The staff is obliged to take action if a guest does not comply with these rules.
17. Pay attention to your energy consumption. Do not let hot water run unnecessarily. Also use electricity consumers sparingly. In summer, electricity consumption is included in the flat rate. In winter you will be billed based on consumption.
17. Make sure to preserve our beautiful nature and take care of it.
18. Charging electric cars on the campsite's electricity poles or in our cabins is not permitted. In the event of a violation, we will levy a fine. For electric vehicles there is a public electric charging station with 2x 150KW and 2x 22KW at Lanthandel (Gammvågen 2).
19. Respect the opening times to allow our staff to rest.
20. Open fires are prohibited on the entire area, with the exception of the fireplace next to the sauna building.
21. The wastewater from mobile homes and caravans must not be drained into the ground. A separate emptying station is available for emptying. Smaller containers can be emptied next to the back entrance of the service house.
22. In the event of a fire/emergency: First rescue, then dial the emergency number 112, extinguish the fire and at the same time inform reception. Locations of fire extinguishers can be found on the overview map.
23. There is a specially designated area on the camping site for washing cars or camping vehicles.
24. We care about the environment and therefore sort waste into separate containers. Bulky waste such as garden furniture, camping equipment and the like must be disposed of at municipal collection points.
25. Motorhomes/Caravans/Tents must be set up as per the image below to comply with fire regulations.



26. If the rules are not followed, staff have the right to eject you and your belongings from the campsite.
